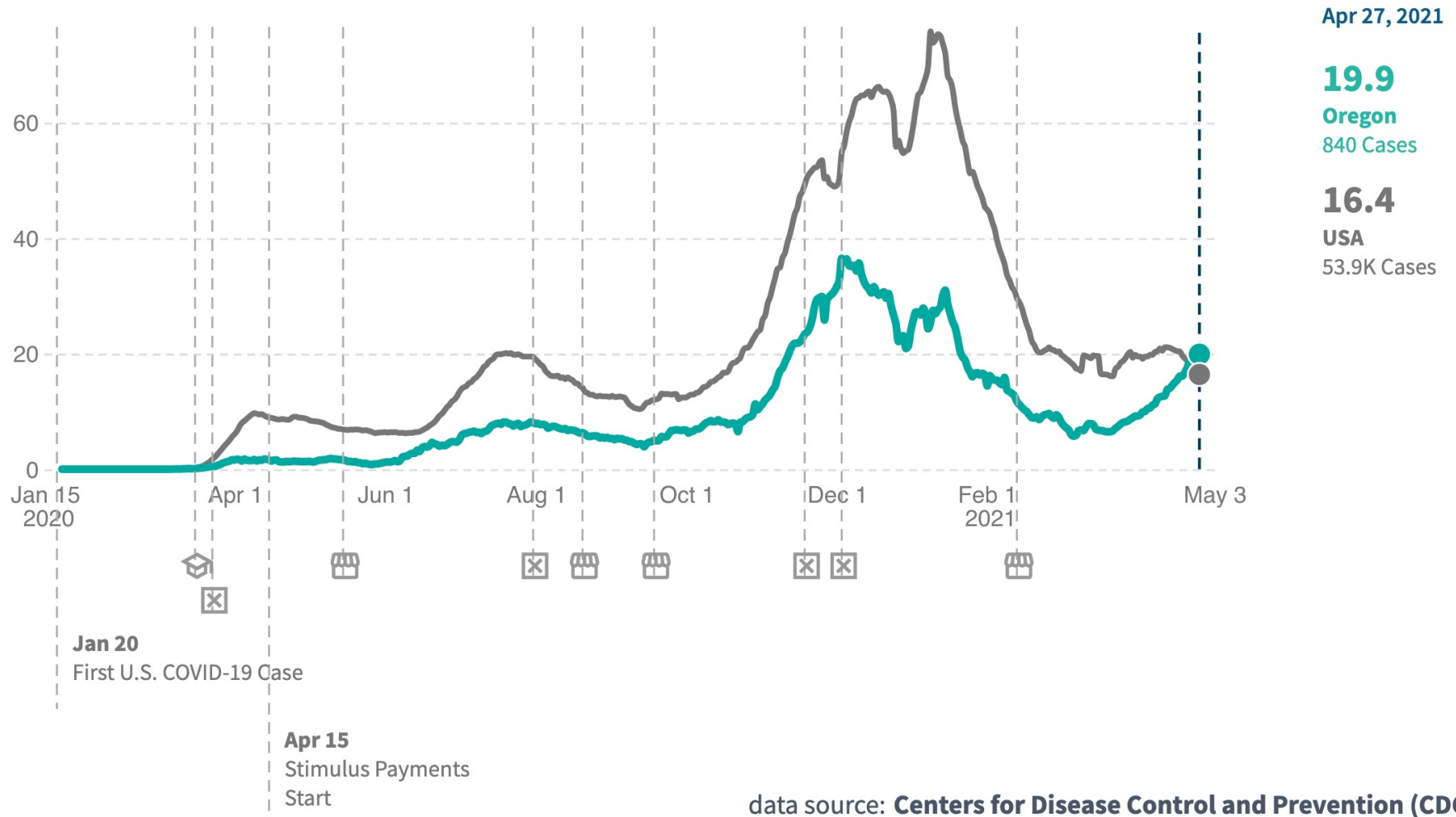

Daily Reported COVID-19 Cases per 100,000 People

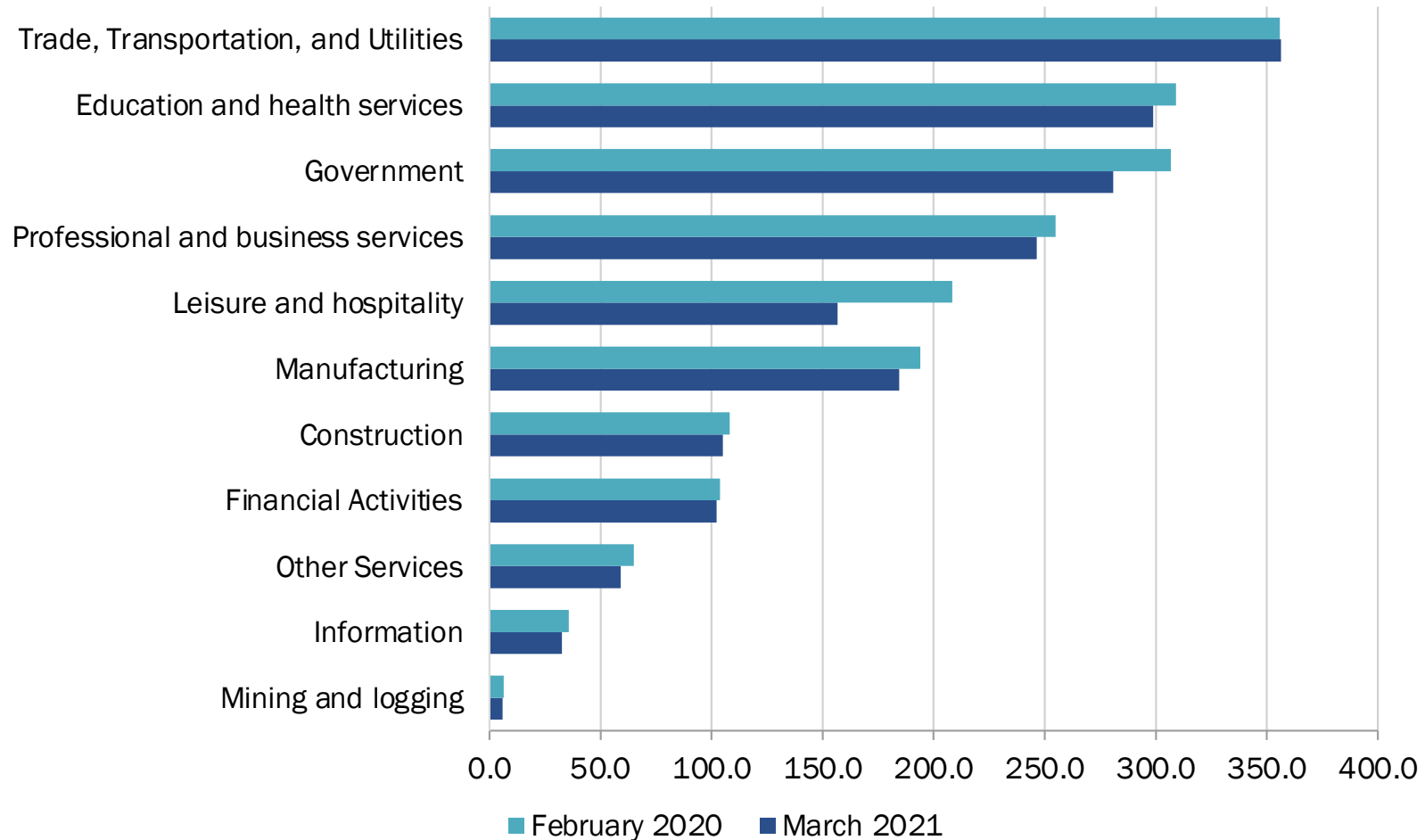
In **Oregon**, on **April 27 2021**, there were **19.9** newly reported COVID-19 cases per 100,000 people.

Employment Still Recovering from Historic Lows

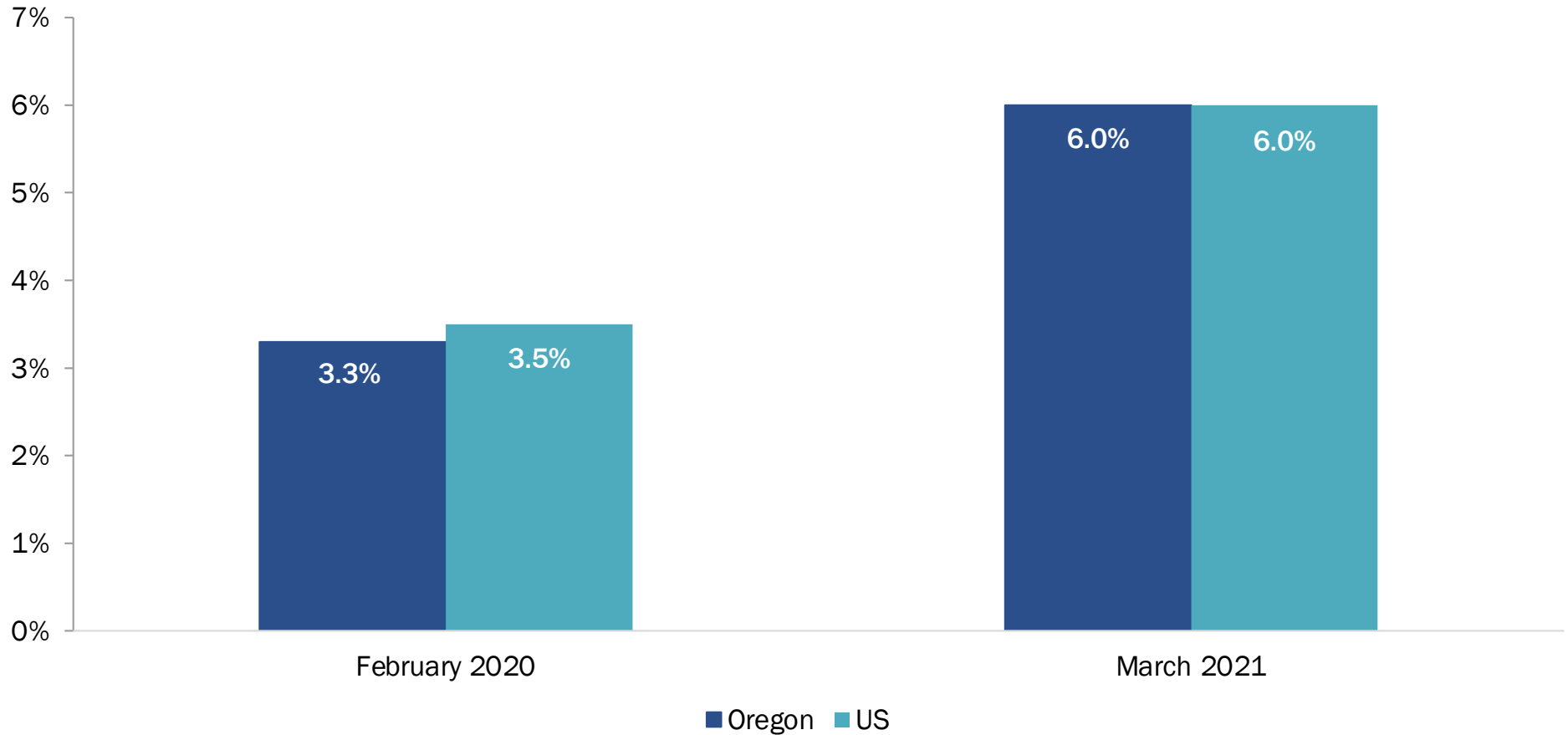
Total Number of Employees (Thousands) by Supersector, February 2020 and March 2021

Oregon's Unemployment Rate

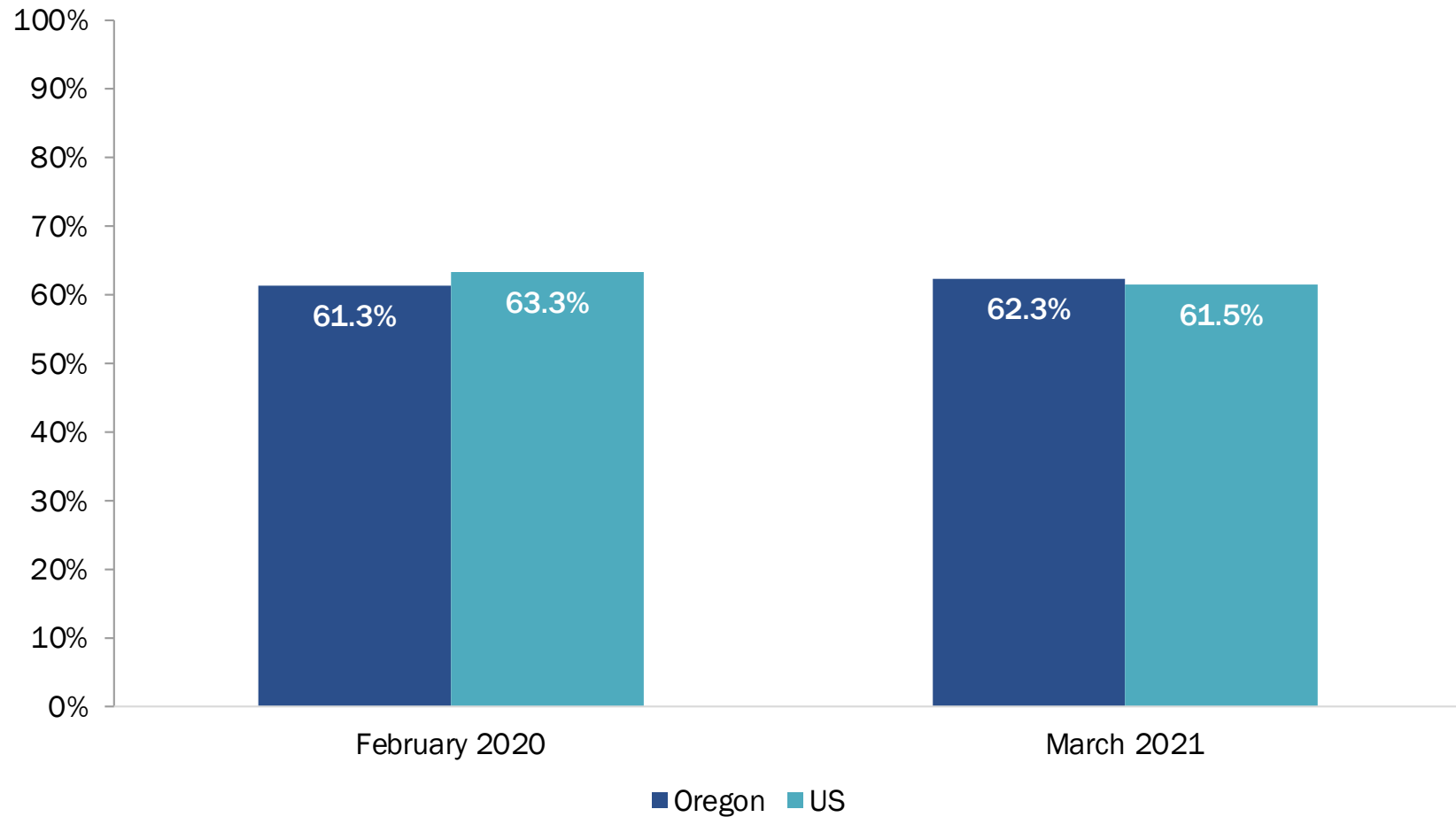
Unemployment Rate, Oregon and US, February 2020 and March 2021

February 2020 and March 2021

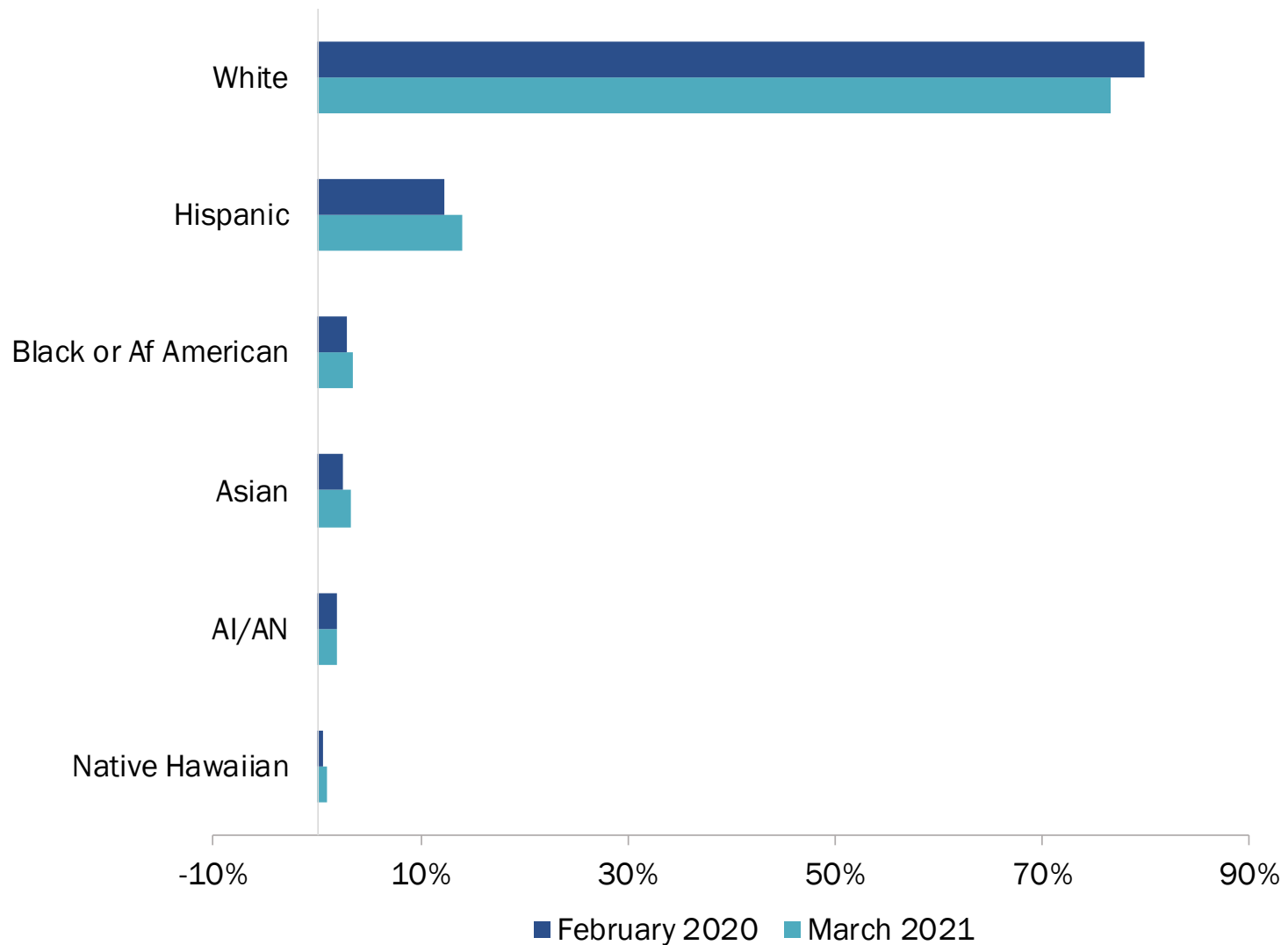

Oregon's Share of Continuing Unemployment Insurance (UI) Claims by Race and Ethnicity, February and March 2021

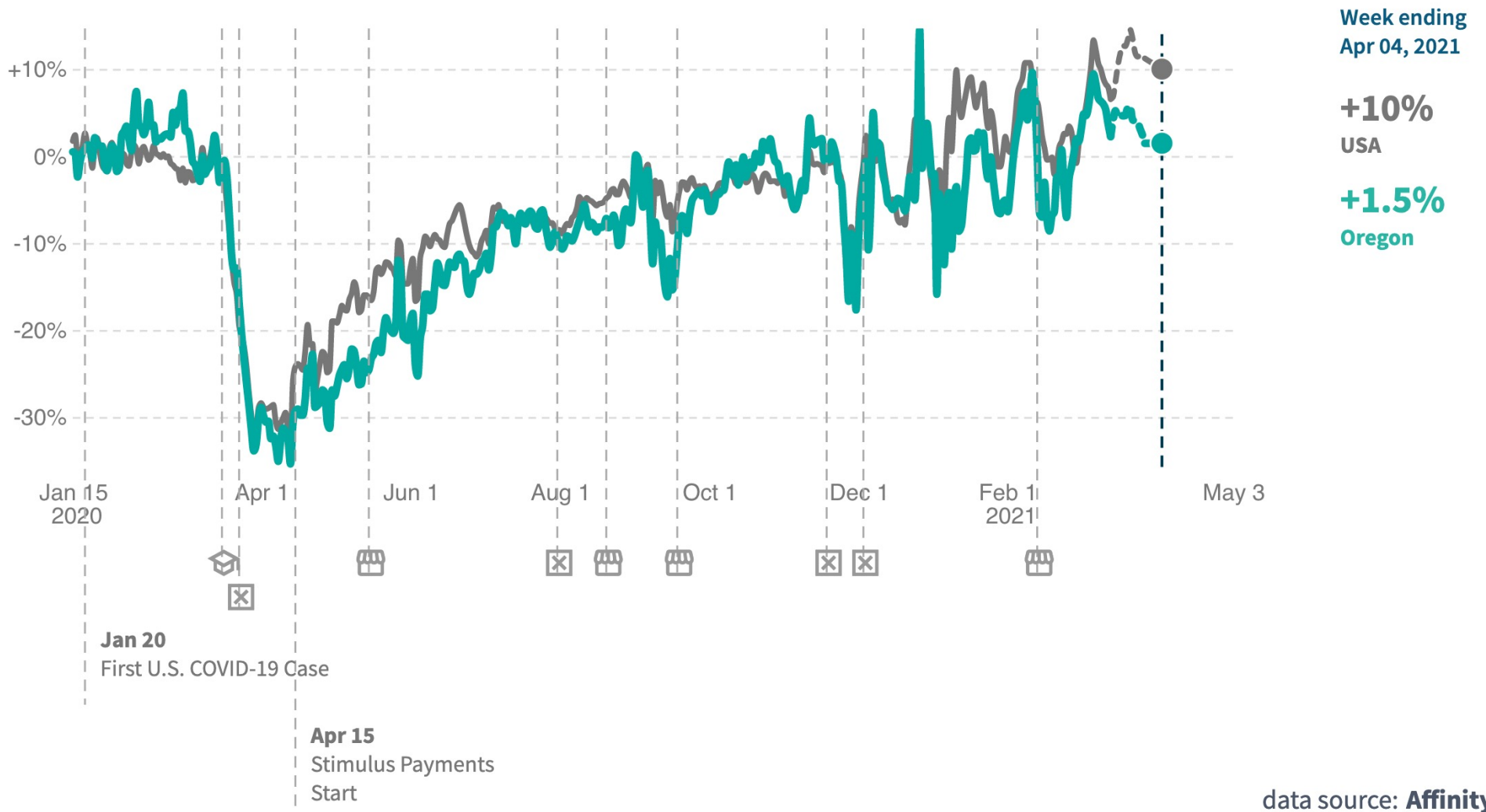

In **Oregon**, as of **April 04 2021**, total spending by all consumers **increased** by **1.5%** compared to January 2020.

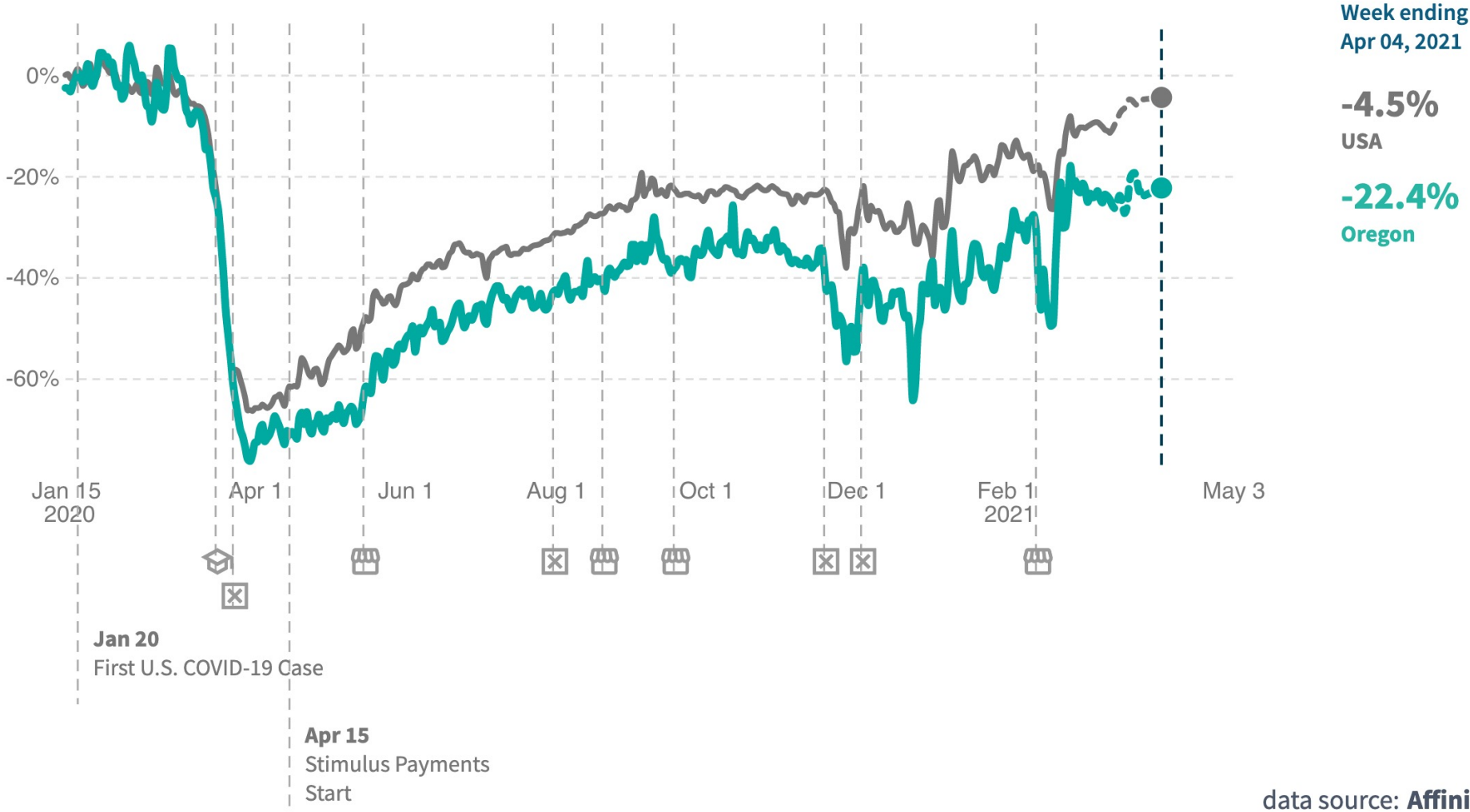

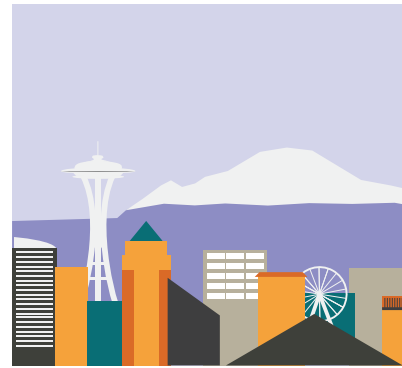
